<u>Trash:</u>

Trash pick-up is on Tuesday mornings. Please put all trash in the Waste Management trash can provided and put it by the curb on Monday night. No electronics, chemicals, yard waste, or construction trash is allowed.

Commonly Violated Local Ordinances with specific

fines/actions attached to each. (please note: this is NOT an all-inclusive list of ordinances)

Leaf Burning: No burning is allowed along curbs or on village streets. No burning is allowed after sunset. Yard waste must be dry when burned. Fires MUST BE attended by a responsible party at all times. Dogs/Cats: No more than three dogs/cats total are allowed at any residence. All dogs must be on a leash unless fenced or on the owner's property.

<u>Permits</u>: A permit is required for any new construction or modifications. This includes fences, homes, outbuildings, decks, patios, etc.

<u>Curfew</u>: A minor is any person who has not yet reached their 18th birthday. Minors are not allowed to be in a public space between the hours of 11:00 P.M. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday until 6:00 A.M. the following day and 12:01 A.M. until 6:00 A.M. Saturday and Sunday. Exceptions are if the minor is with a parent/guardian, travelling to/from a school activity or employment without any detour or stop.

<u>Grass/weeds</u>: Grass and/or weeds must be maintained not in excess of eight (8) inches high. Grass is also to be mowed in such a way that the clippings DO NOT get into the street/curbs. <u>Derelict vehicles</u>: Unlicensed and/or inoperable vehicles are prohibited outside on the premises of any residence.
